This delicate oil and ink painting on panel by Dusso depicts a beautiful and graceful woman seen from behind, her nude figure enhanced by the framing of her hair. Born in Los Angeles, CA on March 21st 1918, Leon Dusso (formerly known as Leon d'Usseau) was a celebrated American artist who studied under the greats Merrill Gauge and Archipenko at the renowned Chouinard Art Institute. During his career, he resided in Sherman Oaks. He passed away on Nov 1991 at Lake Elsinore, CA but his legacy will live on forever through his incredible works of art.
