"Paddling Woman" is a minimalist watercolour that captures the essence of the human experience. Through the delicate strokes of a brush dipped in watercolour, the artist has conveyed the inner turmoil of the main subject, which may be remembering or dreaming of past or previous journeys. Her long, curly hair cascading down her shoulders symbolises the wildness within us all. The simple black ink lines that create the birds and ships in the background add a touch of innocence and childlike wonder, evoking a sense of nostalgia for a simpler time.
